

This is a comprehensive guide to the rock climbs found in Red Rock Canyon National Conservation Area, twenty miles to the west of Las Vegas in Southern Nevada.

Red Rocks offers the climber everything from sport routes and bouldering to big aid walls and long free routes. The reliable weather, beautiful surroundings and great climbing make Red Rocks one of North America's most popular destinations during the fall, winter, and spring.

This book provides detailed information on over 1700 climbs, using full written descriptions, maps, topos and photodiagrams. To provide historical background I have included a history, written with Larry DeAngelo, and essays by Joanne Urioste, John Long and Larry Hamilton. To give a feel for the climbing there are over 60 action shots spread throughout the text, many featuring routes that have never appeared in print before.
